In spite of the weather, the children say that they have really enjoyed getting outside to do some of their learning this term.



Foundation Stage children have been exploring the environment as pirates.

On one wild, wet and windy day in January they discovered what it must feel like to be on a ship in a storm!

Year 1 have been learning about living things.

They have searched for hibernating minibeasts and animal homes. They planted an Oak tree in the wild area.



Year 2 sessions have focused on measurement and shape.

They have compared lengths and measured in centimetres and metres.





Year 3 and Year 4 have done some story stepping about the Egyptian creation story. They created their own worlds using natural materials.

They are also investigating soil for their science work.



Year 5 and 6 have been learning to perform a poem, and writing their own poems based on their experiences outside.
